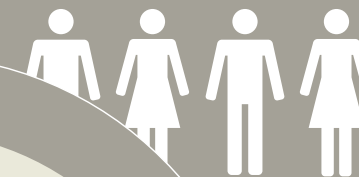

ANU supports students by offering the lowest level of tuition among all universities in Korea so that they can walk a path of flowers.

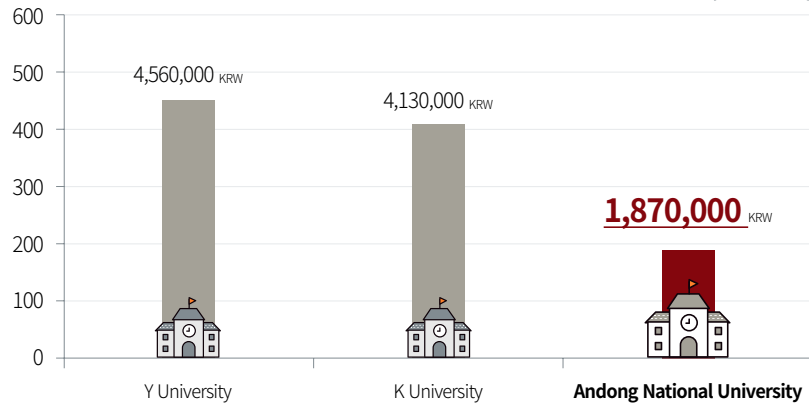

Support for Employment / Startup and Consultation Program

ANU supports students for their successful advance into society.

The job program helps students to search for their careers, select them, and become equipped for them. It also gives them confidence to get a job by being prepared.

Career Development Programs

- By building and managing a system called My Success Plan (MSP), this program helps students to create a Road Map and to put it into practice so that they can grow, develop, and systematically manage their campus experience to decide on their career.
- Credits or scholarships will be awarded according to performance in completing counseling, career, employment, and startup programs.

Employment Support Consulting

- The one-on-one counseling with a job consultant supports students to design their careers and strengthen their capabilities. Students can later apply for companies with confidence by systematically preparing for employment from freshmen or sophomore years.
- Job placement: Via job consulting, we provide customized career guidance and employment information for students seeking jobs by analyzing their aptitude, capabilities, desired conditions, etc. We actively support students to be hired by cooperating with companies that are searching for new employees.
- Caregiver interviews and participating job fairs

Student Counseling

- The counseling office is conducting counseling, psychological testing services, and other various activities for students to keep a healthy mindset, become well adapted to campus life and mature. Personal counseling and group counseling are provided to solve the many problems that students face and to help them to grow.
- Group counseling: Group counseling for mental growth, raising self-esteem, fostering peer counselors, job search, reinforcing employment capabilities, and for low performers
- Psychological testing: MBTI, MMPI, KSCL, SCT, Holland, etc.

Campus Job Center

- Counseling experts offer one-on-one and customized job counseling to students in their freshmen or sophomore year by considering their college and jobs

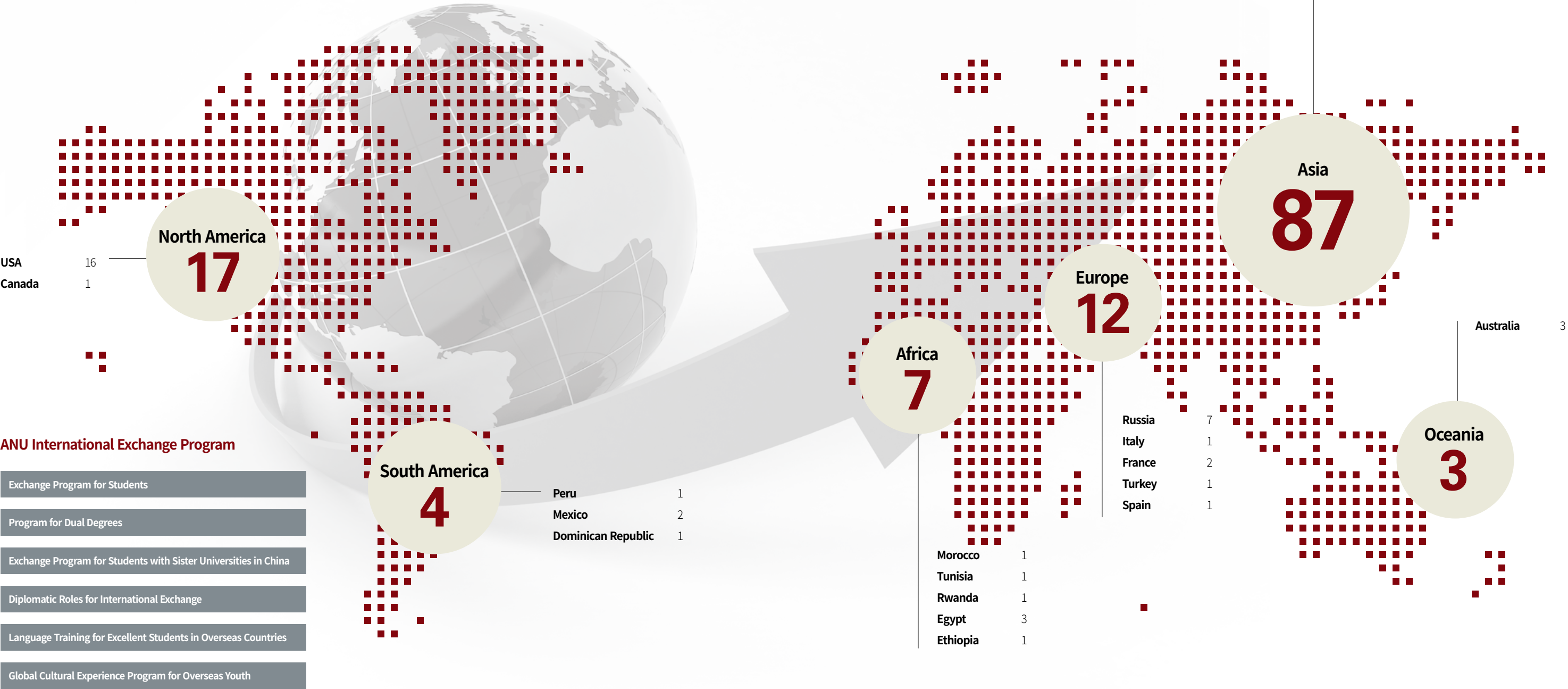
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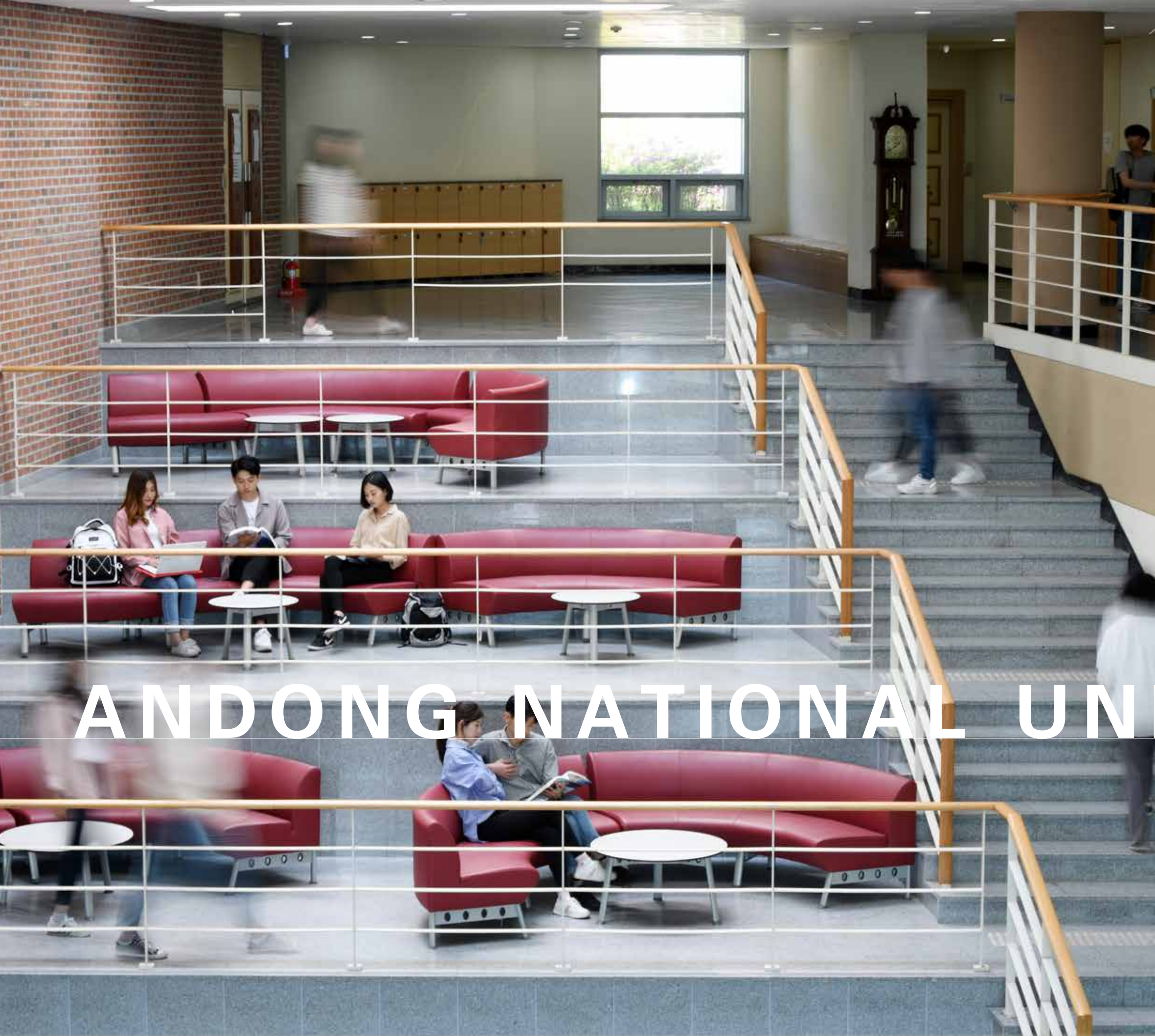

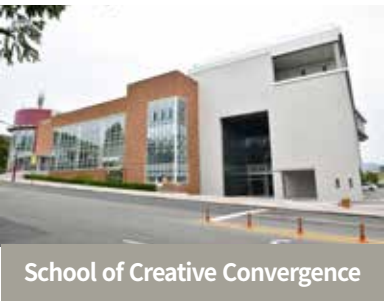

Introduction of Andong

Andong, the Window to Korea's 5,000-Year-Old Culture

Andong preserves the prototype of Korea's Confucian culture as the capital of Korea's spiritual culture. Dating back to old times, various Korean cultures, including the common people's culture, all have naturally permeated throughout the Andong area. Understanding the culture of Andong can be likened to understanding the culture of Korea. Meet Korea in Andong, the window to Korea's 5,000-year-old culture.



● A Place that Breathes Spiritual Culture, a Hallowed Ground of the Independence Movement

Andong is a shrine to the independence movement as a place where people have always stood up courageously and defended the country in times of trouble. Andong produced the largest number of independence activists, measuring up to 1,100 people, and it was recorded as the first place to host an independence movement in Korea, when 'Andong's Righteous Army' rose up in 1894. Andong is a place where one can find the spiritual culture of Korea.

● Andong Maskdance Festival, Korea's Representative Festival

The Andong Maskdance Festival is a festival held in Andong and created by the locals and enjoyed by the people of the world. Andong Maskdance Festival is a festival where visitors can encounter masks and mask dances from all over the world, and it reflects the values of the Eastern World. You can feel Korea through the spirit of the Maskdance Festival Andong's culture and the joys of the festival can be experienced at the same time.

● Embrace the World in Andong, a UNESCO World Heritage City

World Heritage refers to a legacy that is acknowledged as having the worth of protection for the sake of all humankind, organized by the World Heritage Committee. Hahoe Village, Bongjeongsa Temple, Dosanseowon Confucian Academy, and Byeongsanseowon Confucian Academy of Andong are all listed as World Heritage, recognized for their traditions and values. Visitors can encounter Korea's present day in Andong, a place that inherits and maintains tradition and culture for all of humanity, not just Koreans.



Tourist Sites

- **Hahoe Village**

Andong's Hahoe Village was listed as a World Heritage Site by the 34th session of the UNESCO World Heritage Committee held in Brazil in July 2010. This village was chosen because the various lifestyles and cultures that are being passed down by the villagers are now being regarded as having worth for protection and succession. Due to this worth, the committee decided that not only Koreans, but also people from around the world should protect and care for this village. Andong Hahoe Village stands out as the symbolic place where the traditional Confucian culture of Korea is still alive and breathing. Hahoe Folk Village is a clan village with the most original, Korean-style culture, and it is the most famous tourist attraction in Andong. The village's visitors have included England's Queen Elizabeth II; the Queen's second son, Prince Andrew; the 41st President of the United States, President George H.W. Bush; and the 43rd President, George W. Bush..



- **Bongjeongsa Temple**



Andong's Bongjeongsa Temple was listed as a World Heritage Site through the 42nd session of the UNESCO World Heritage Committee held in Bahrain in June 2018. The temple was chosen as it retains the Korea's oldest wooden building in existence, which is also one of Korea's National Treasures. Bongjeongsa Temple is evaluated as having historical and religious values, as home to Geungnakjeon Hall(Paradise Shrine), which embodies the characteristics of dapu-style buildings. Living up to its nickname, "Korea's Architectural Museum," Bongjeongsa Temple boasts a wide variety of architectural constructions built in times ranging from Goryeo to Joseon Dynasty. As it is an old temple, it exhibits a variety of attractions, including many national treasures and tangible cultural properties, including the National Treasure of Korea, Geungnakjeon Hall(Paradise Shrine).

- **Dosanseowon and Byeongsanseowon Confucian Academie**

Andong's Dosanseowon Confucian Academy and Byeongsanseowon Confucian Academy were listed as World Heritage Sites through the 43rd session of the UNESCO World Heritage Committee held in Azerbaijan in July 2019. Both Confucian academies were regarded as possessing universal values that the people of the world should protect and inherit, as the traces of cultural tradition associated with the Neo-Confucianism of Korea, which remains in existence until the present day in the form of education and social customs. In addition, its 500-year-old Confucianism value of cultural heritage was highly regarded in that it demonstrates the historical process how the concept of Neo-Confucianism changes in accordance with the conditions of Korea. The two Confucian academies boast sceneries through which visitors can appreciate the architectural beauty of Korea, displaying the harmony between nature and orderliness.

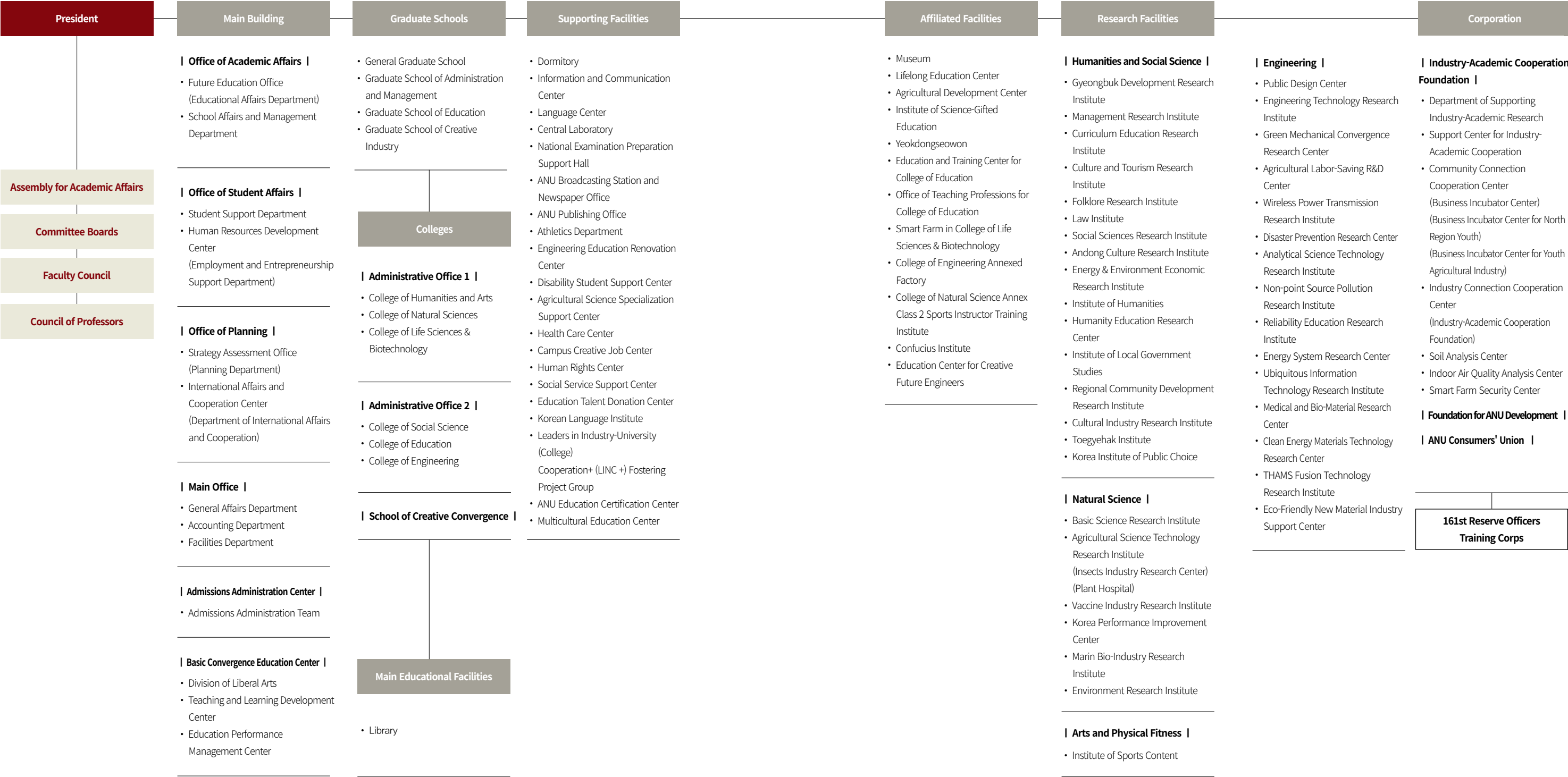

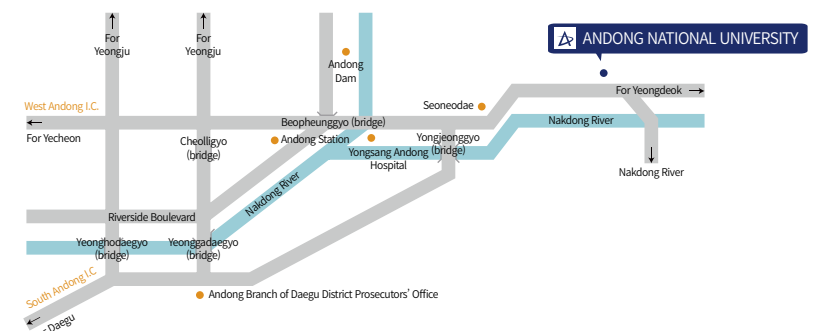
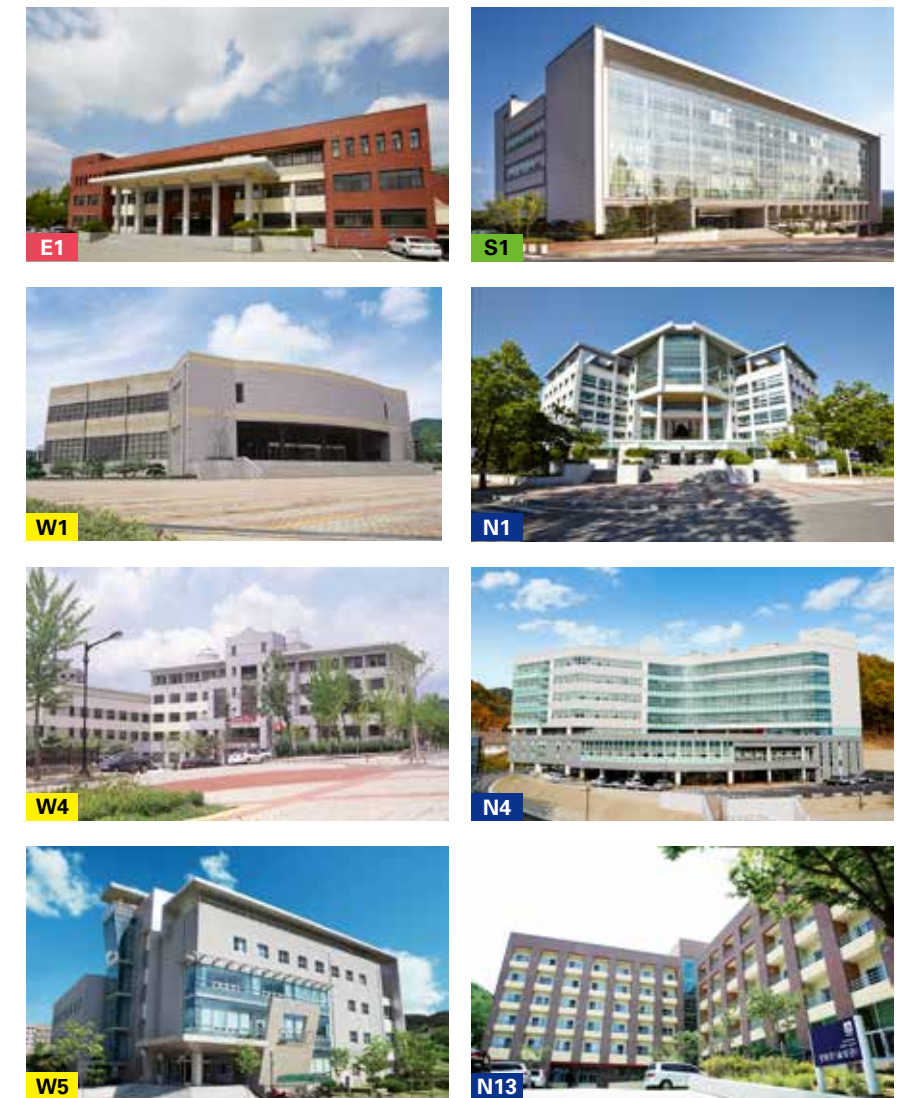
